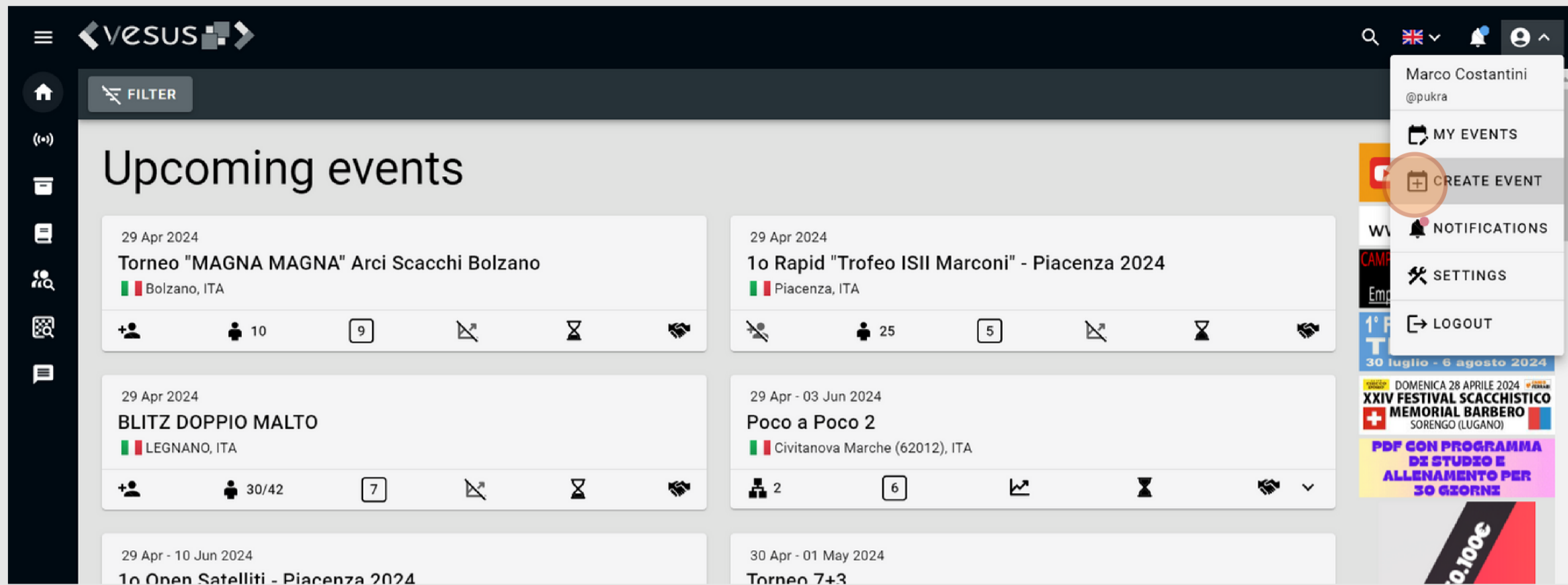

- **FREE:** no licence, no limitations, no usage restrictions
- Available on the Cloud 24h
- No downloads, no installations, no manual updates
- Compatible with Windows, Mac, Linux, iOS, Android and more
- Multi-account and multi-device collaboration
- Implements all FIDE rules for Swiss, RoundRobin, and tie-breaks
- Direct publishing on Vesus.org, the most advanced Chess Web Application (with an average of 1 million page-views per month)
- Generates reports and even a standalone Tournament Website for independent publishing

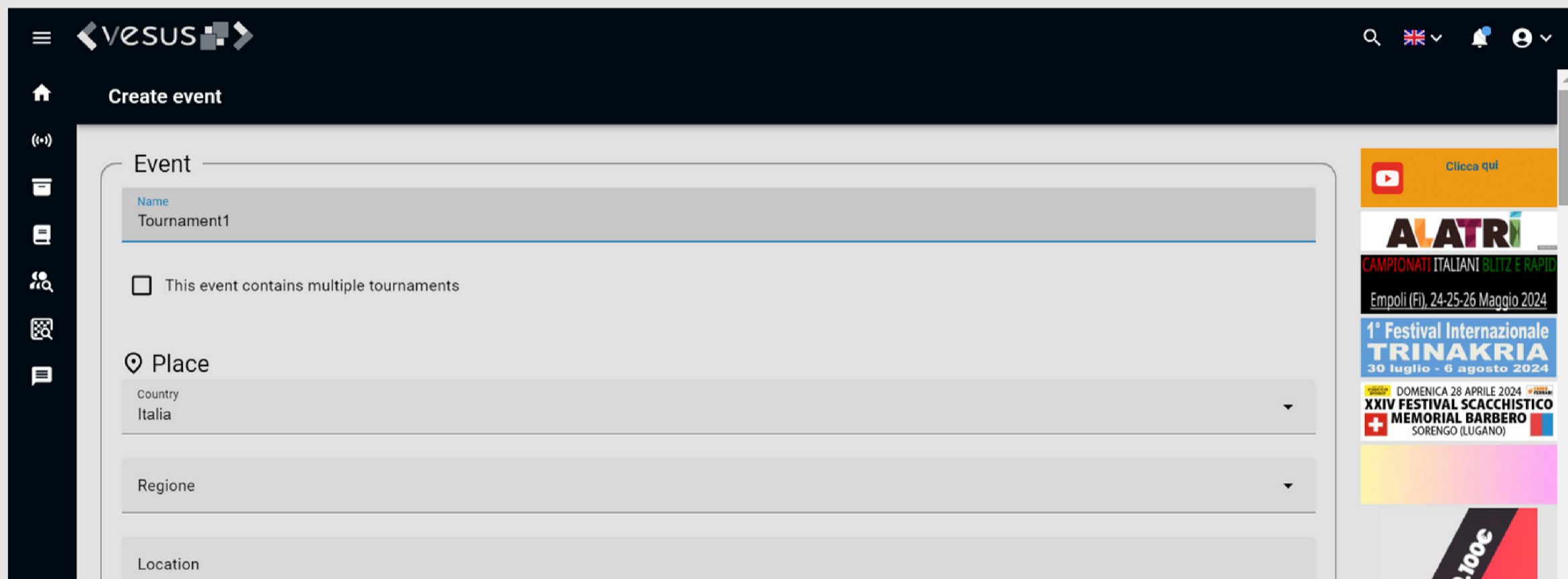
Login to your vesus.org account and create an Event

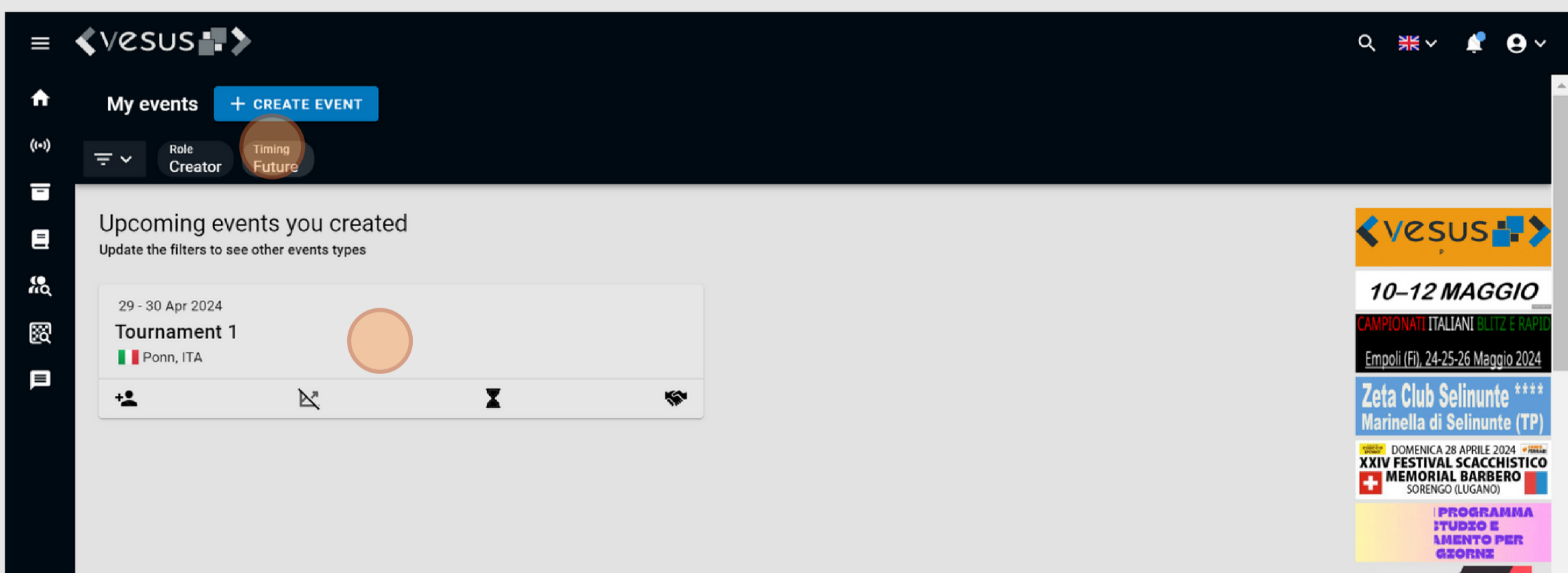
Fill out and submit the form to create the event

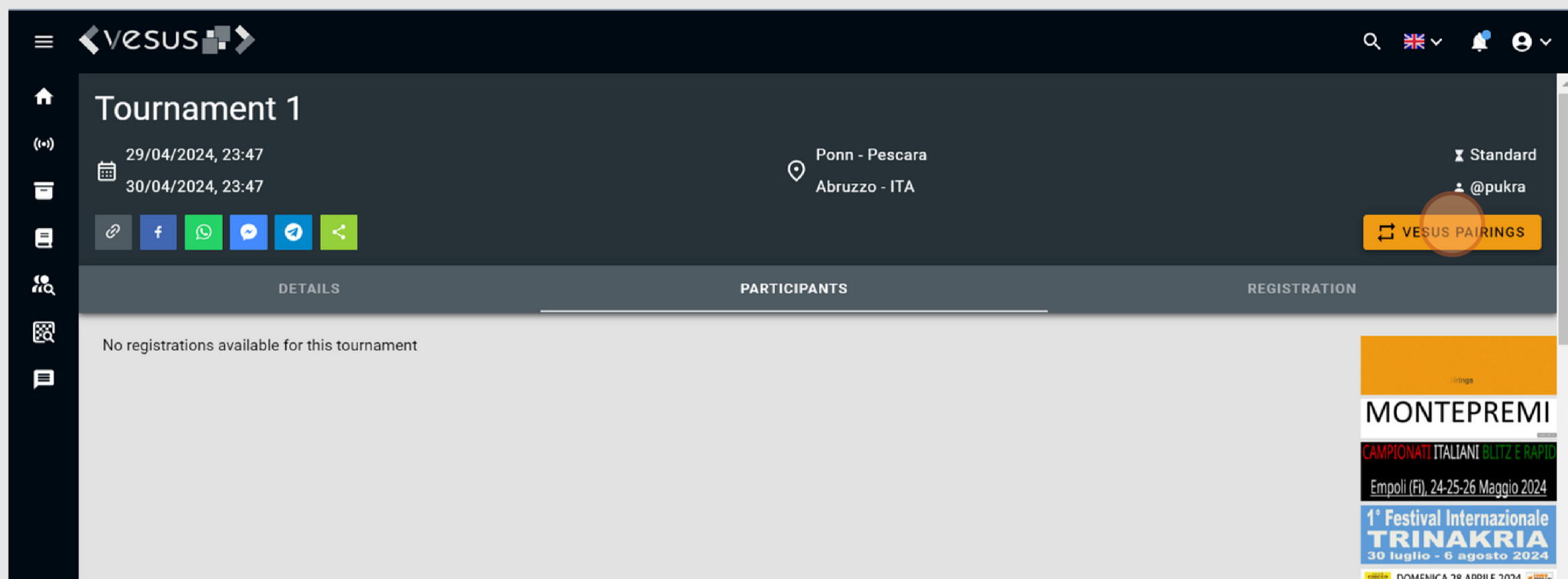


Locate your event (use the filters for future/in progress events)
and enter your tournament page

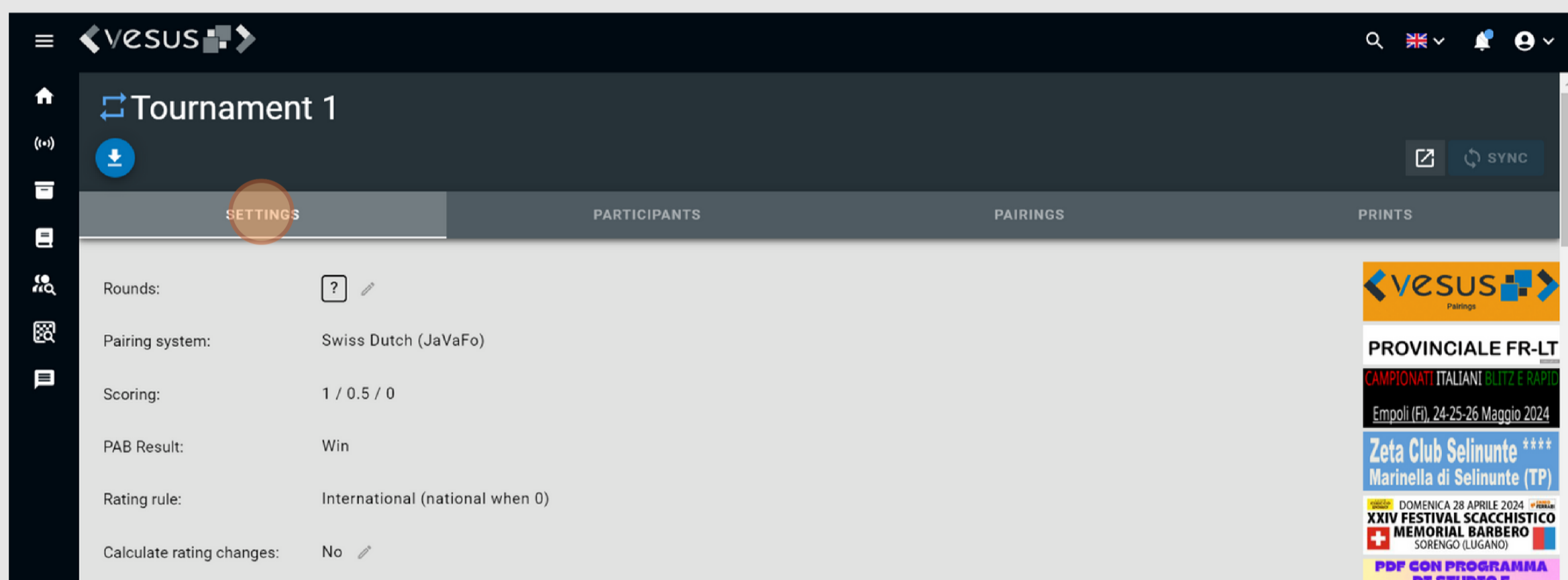

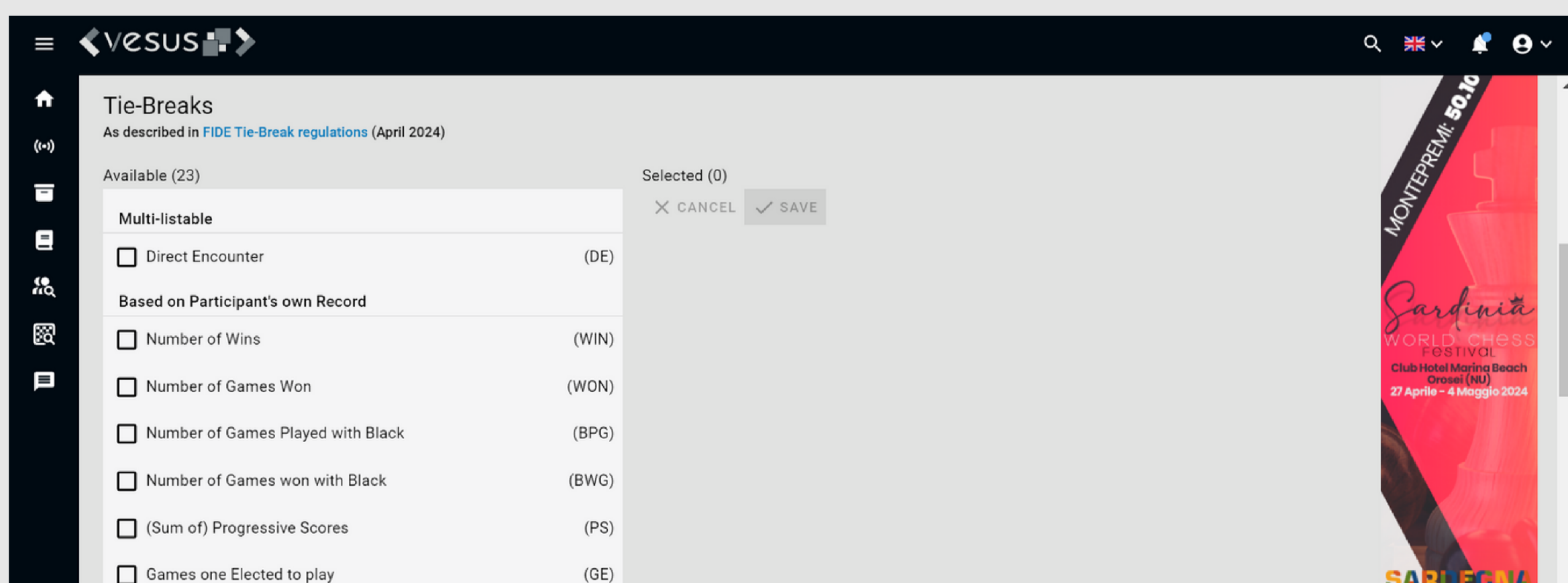
Click the orange VESUS PAIRINGS button to access the pairings software on the cloud



Set the SETTINGS for your tournament (rounds, pairing system, scoring, etc.)



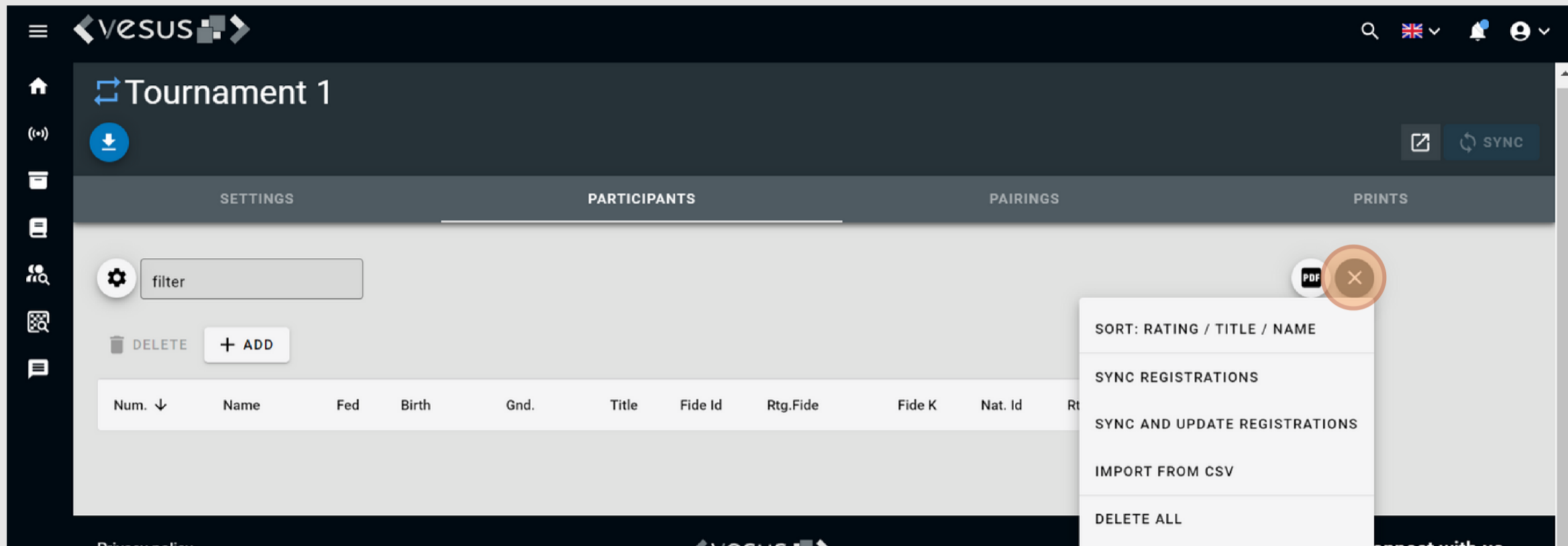
Select the Tie-Breaks to use for calculating the standings



Time to enter Participants.

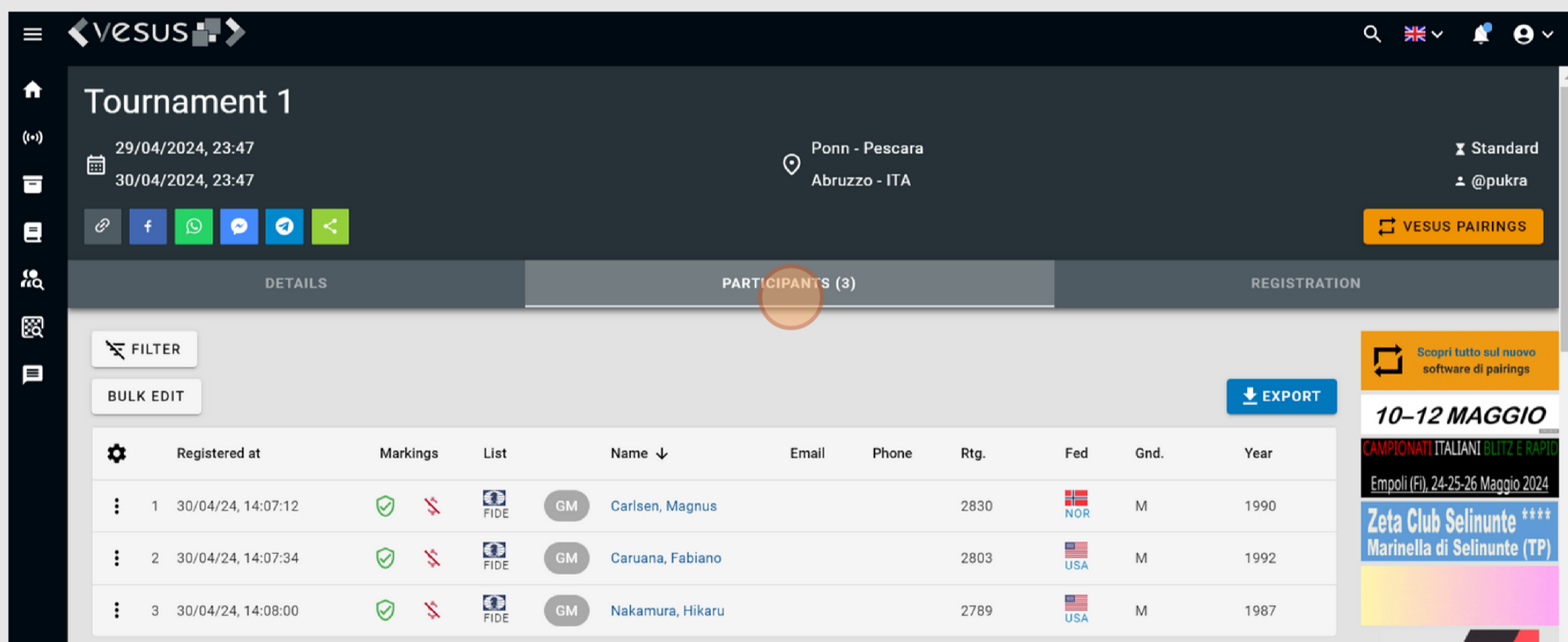
You may decide to synchronise registered participants; add participants manually or upload multiple participants from a CSV file. The 3 approaches are shown below.

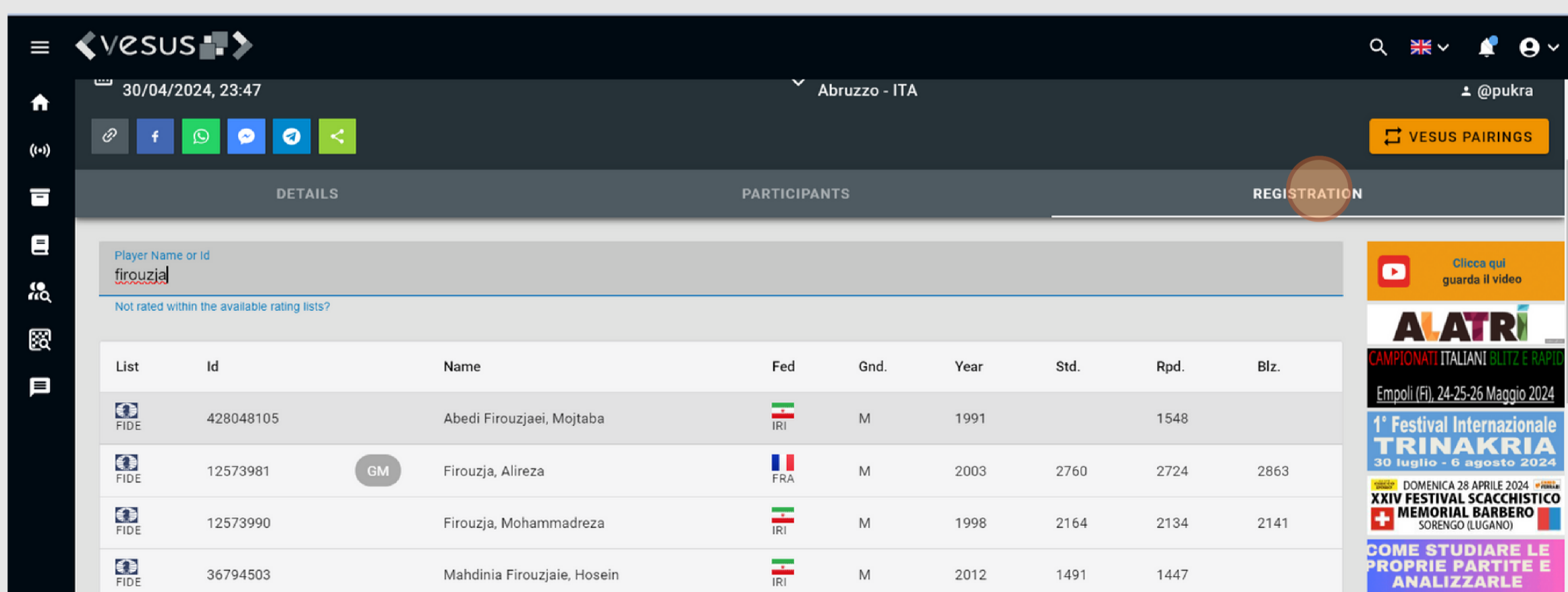
Check your registered participants on the "Public Page"

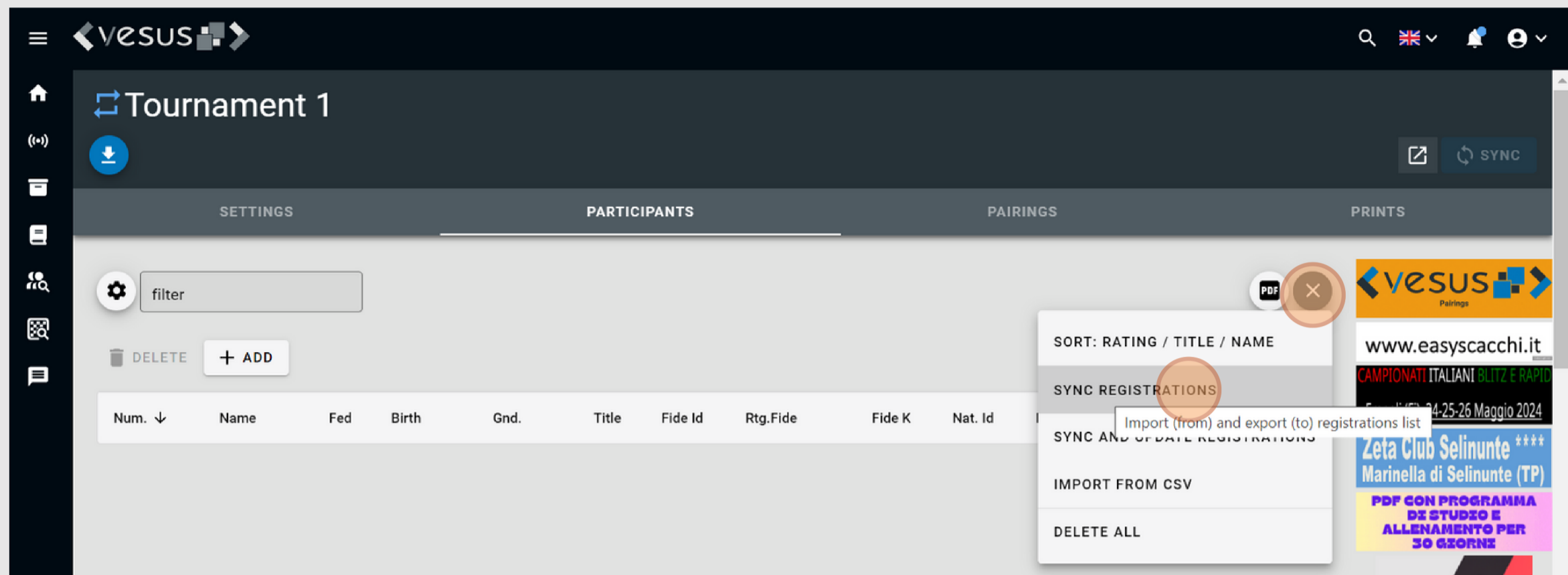
You can register more players through the "Registration" tab

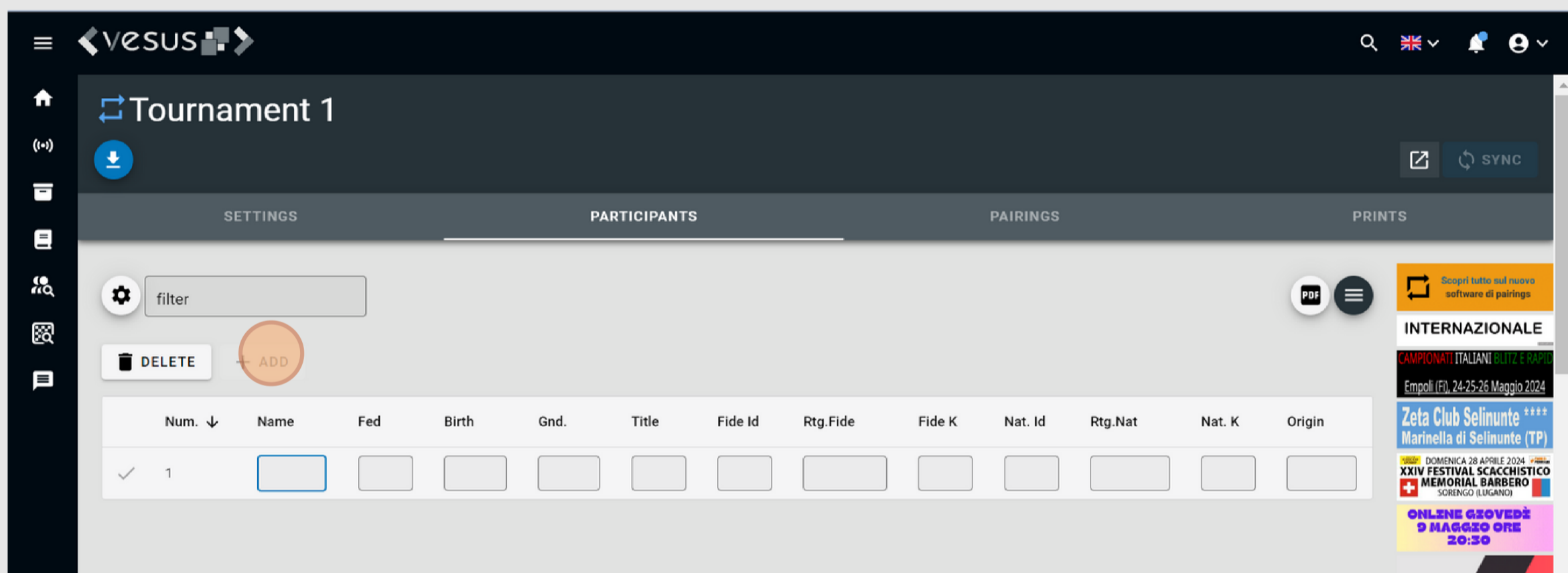
Go back to Vesus Pairings and import registered participants by clicking

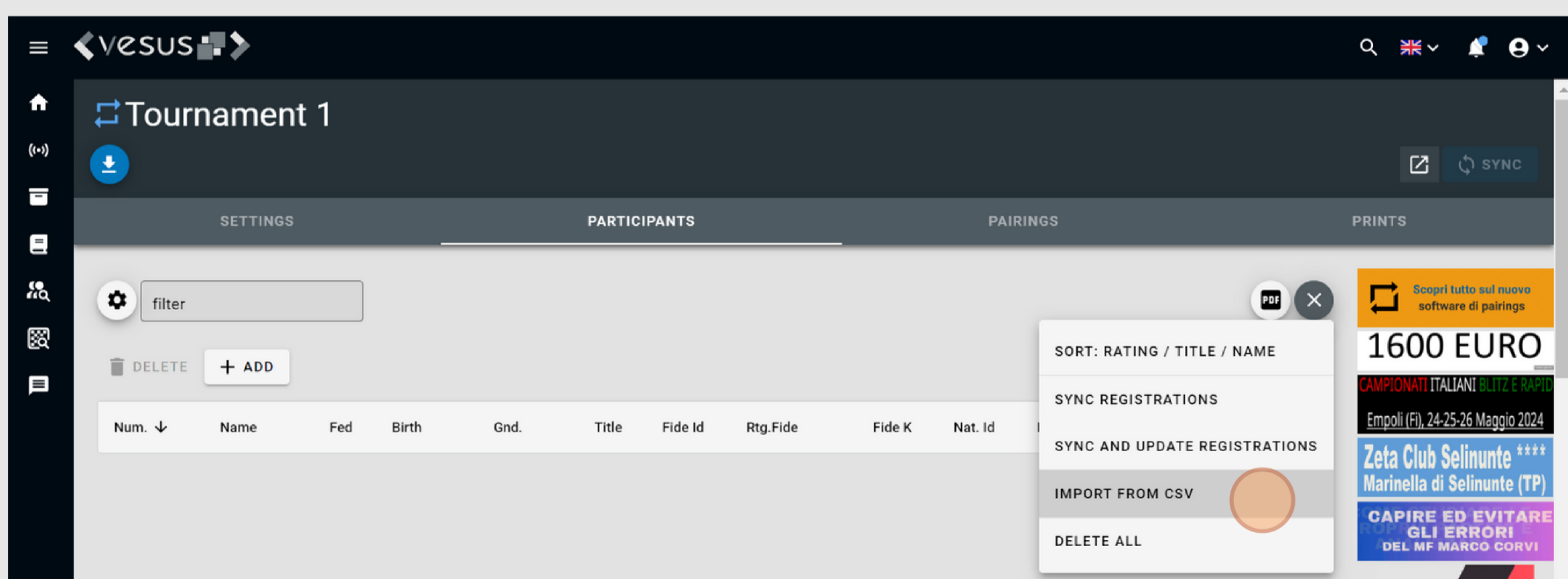
Click the ADD button to enter participants manually by filling their details

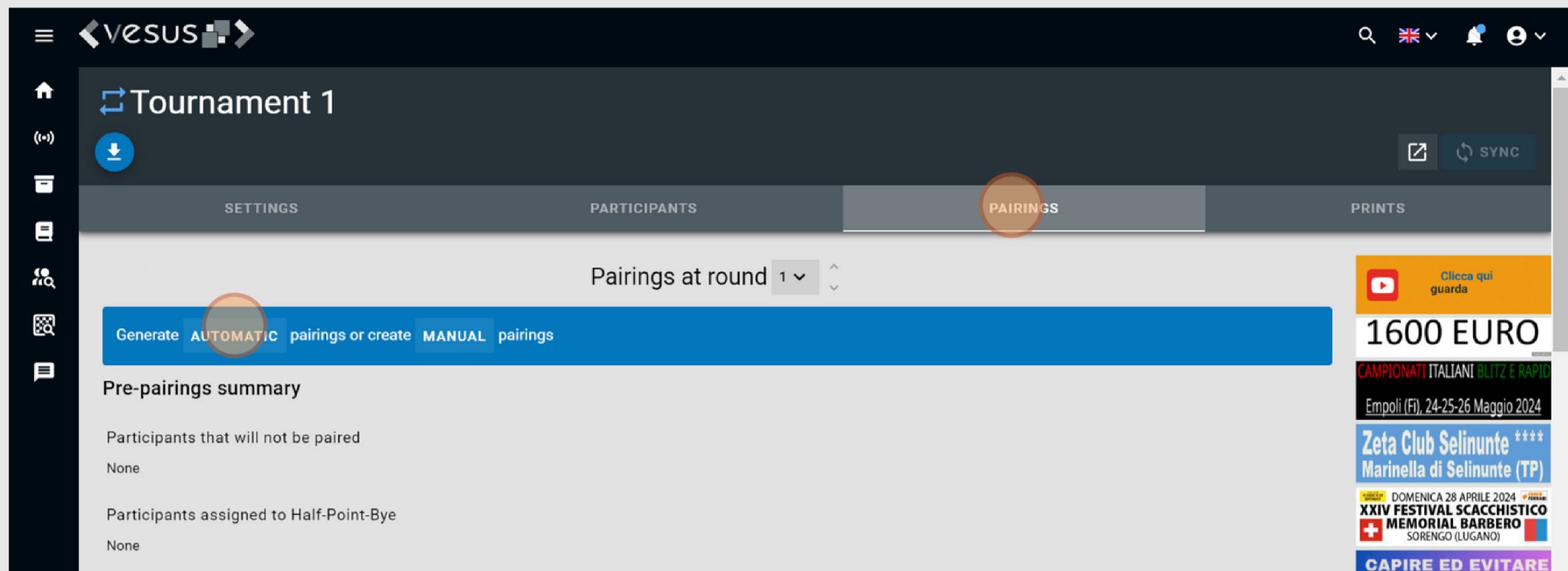
You can also "Import from CSV" multiple participants at once

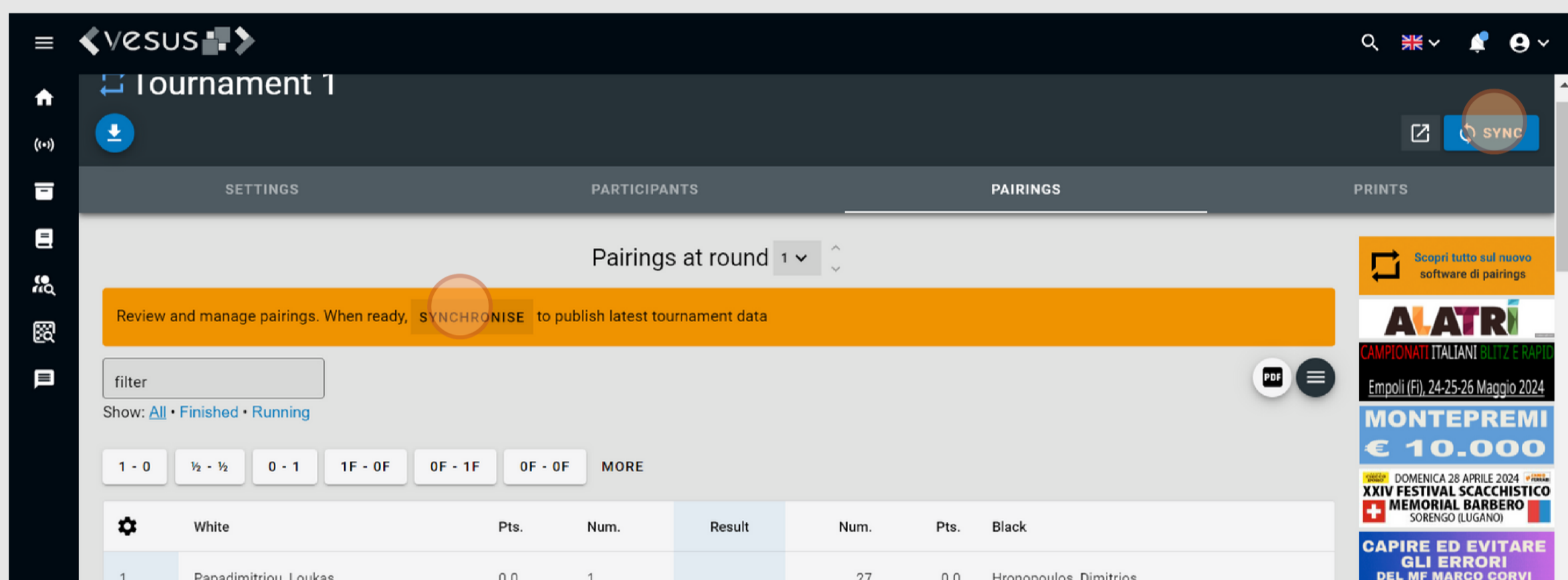
Go to the PAIRINGS tab and click AUTOMATIC to generate computer pairings

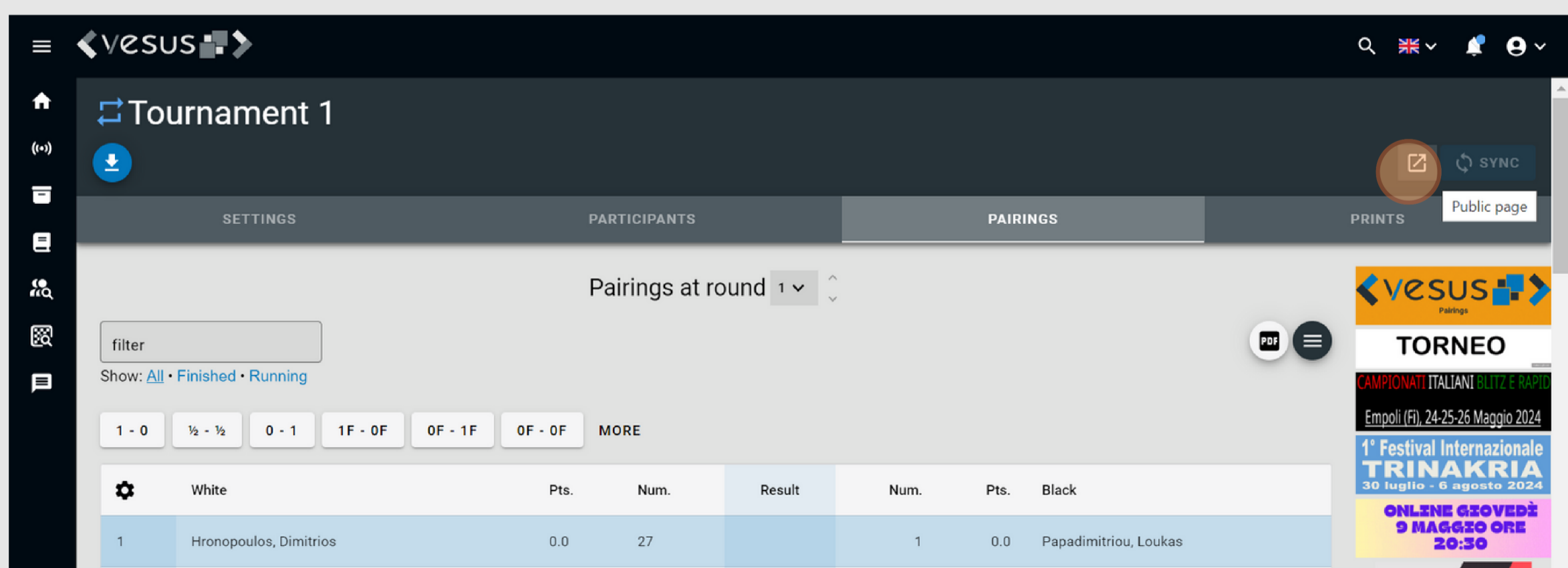
After you check and are happy with the pairings click any of the SYNC buttons to make tournament data publicly available

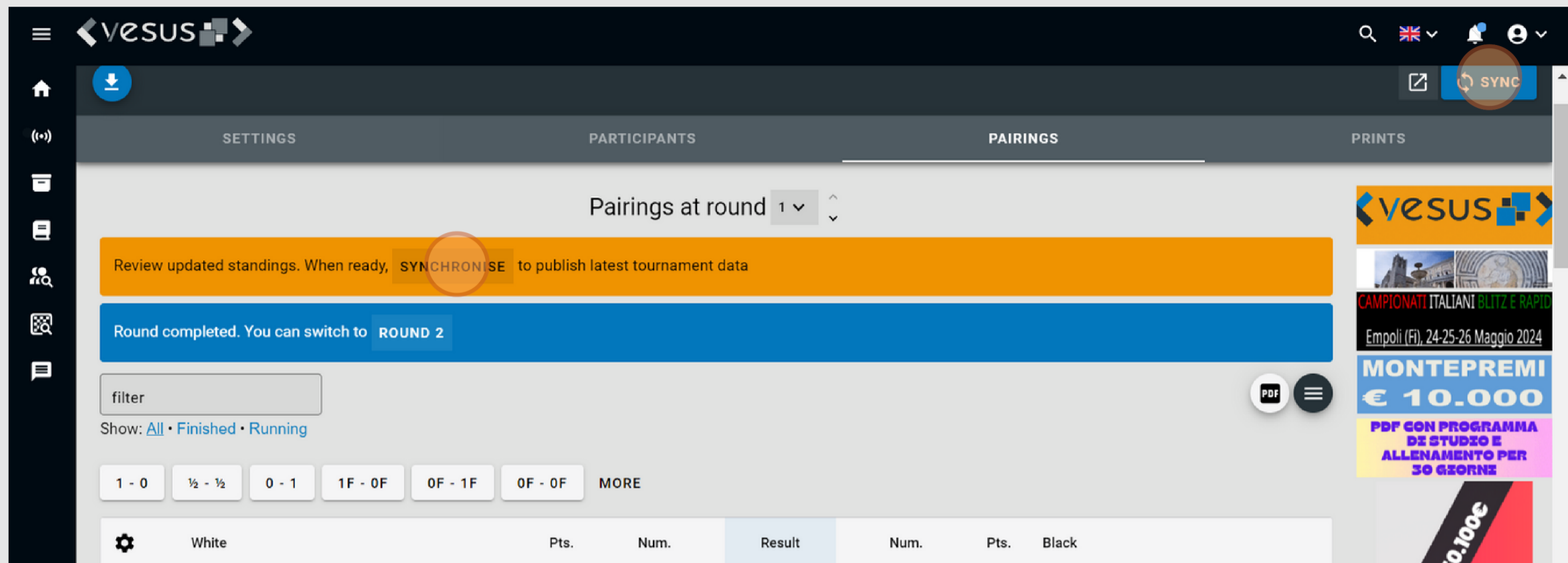
When you enter results for a published round these are immediately available on the "Public Page"

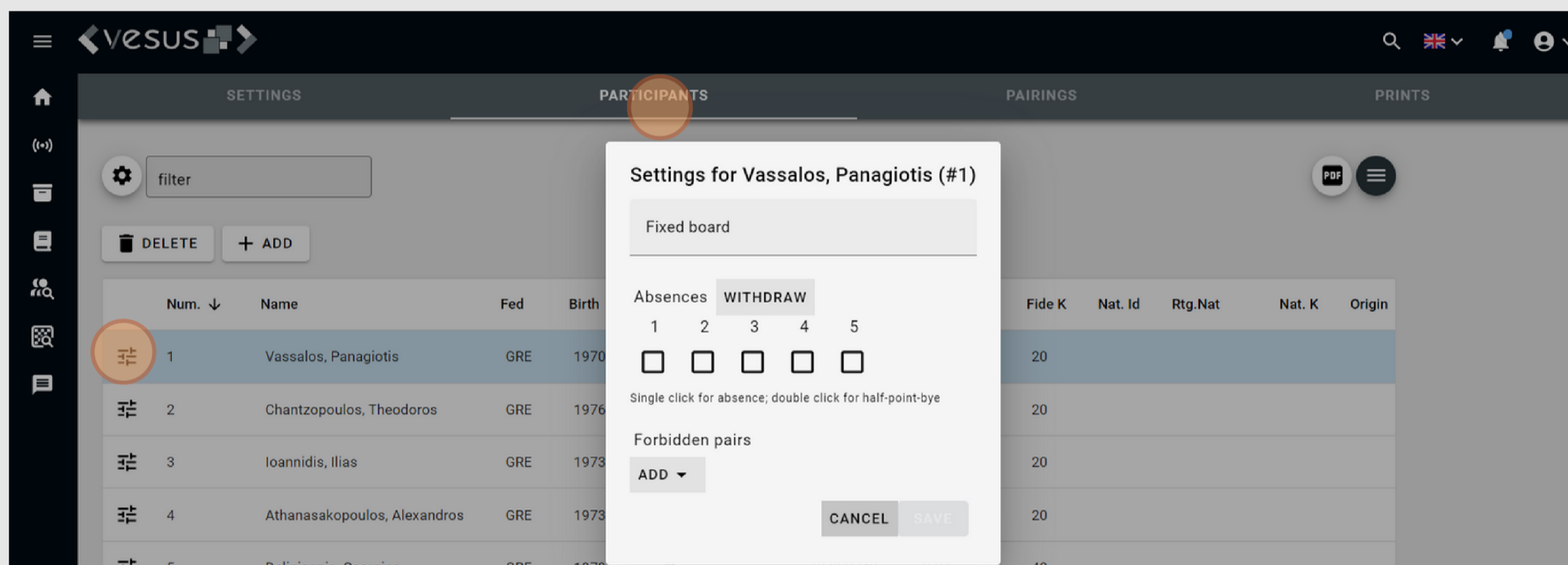
When you complete a round or pair a new round you can SYNC to publish standings and pairings
